1. Applications must be submitted to AviAssist by email or Wetransfer.com by Tuesday, August 17, 2021 and should include 4 things, namely:
 - One page abstract (no more than 250 words)
 - Résumé or curriculum vitae
 - The completed presenter information form ([this](#) form)
 - A one (1) minute test video in which you present yourself to help us evaluate your recording skills - kindly see this video for guidance: <https://bit.ly/3qqf5wG>
2. Presenters will be selected on the basis of content, applicability and delivery.
3. Each author will be responsible for her or his own video recording of the final presentation conforming to AviAssist quality standards and guidelines that will be provided to the selected presenters.
4. Submittal of an abstract implies agreement that the author shall transfer copyright of the abstract and the final presentation to the Foundation.
5. Final presentations will be no longer than 7 minutes. Questions and answers will be dealt with in a session after a series of presentations. Experience has shown that if you were to write out your complete presentation to learn it by heart, you should aim for approximately 120 words per minute. This means that the written script of your video presentation should be around 850 words.
